

History

While driving through the Kavango Region, you likely noticed herds of multicoloured cattle in the veld or crossing the road. Here at Taranga Safari Lodge, you will see them grazing on the banks of the Okavango and sometimes swimming across the river with only their heads and horns above the water.

For as long as there were people in Africa, their lives have been intrinsically tied to their cattle. The nomadic lifestyle of ancient people, whose life, culture, language and entire existence depended on cattle, brought the Nguni breed to the Kavango Region many centuries ago. Refined by time, their genetic code has been shaped by the harshness of the continent, making them a symbol of the achievements of ancient Africa.

The Nguni cattle remain central to the traditional Kavango everyday life. They are used for transport of goods, ploughing of agricultural land, and they support communities as a key source of food.

Nguni cattle are symbolic of a traditional African man's wealth and status. In addition, cattle are in many instances seen as the intermediary between people and the spirit world. A beast is slaughtered at weddings, funerals and other significant events, which is said to bring the ancestral shades closer to the living.

They make up the lobola, a gift of cattle from a groom's family to that of his bride. Lobola is more than a bride price; it is the way of cementing the kinship relationships that are so important in Kavango life.
